From Austin, go S. on I-35 to Exit 159B (Walters-Ft. Sam Houston). Use R lane of access road to Ervin St. (First street after the Econo Lodge). Go R one block to Jim St. Going N. on I-35, Exit 159B. Continue on access to Walters. Go L over I-35 for one block to Jim St. Go R. on Jim. In the second block between the 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> house, go L. into the alley for TBM parking. Watch for our TBM signs.

Coming from the north on I-35, take exit 253 to US 79 North in Round Rock to Hutto. Just east of Toll Road 130 in Hutto, go R (south) on FM 685 so. Go 5.1 mi. to Kelly Lane. Go left (east) for 2.4 mi. to Weiss. Go L (no) .3 mi. Weiss curves R, but go L. on Hodde Lane. Church is .3 mi. on R.

From NE on US 79 So., follow directions above from Hutto. From So. On I-35, take Howard Lane, exit # 245. Go E. to Dessau Rd. Go L. (no.) 5.5 mi. to Kelly Lane. Follow directions from Kelly Lane.

From S.E. on US 290, 3 mi. w. of Manor, exit N. on Parmer Ln. (FM 734). Go 5.2 mi. to Dessau Rd. Go R. (No) 6.8 mi to Kelly Lane, Turn R(East) and follow above directions from Kelly Lane.

There is good level parking but only have room for 15 trailers. Call me or Johnny Kluth before you get here.

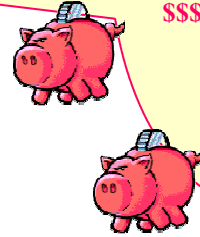
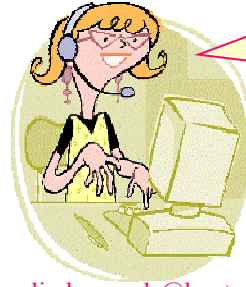
